


THE VISION

"A combination Jesuit seminary, Israeli kibbutz and Marine Corps boot camp"





- 75 Million+ Hours of Work Improving and Protecting California's Natural Resources










OUR BUDGET






CORPSMEMBER BENEFITS





- Work on fire lines to stop and slow the spread of wildland fires
- Earn wildland firefighting certifications
- Leads to jobs with CAL FIRE, U.S. Forest Service, BLM, L.A. City Fire, Ventura County Fire, and more!

FOREST HEALTH

- Remove dead and dying vegetation posing fire hazards
- Tree felling, brush removal, and building fire breaks
- Earn tree felling, chainsaw, and arbor certifications
- Can lead to jobs with private forestry companies, CAL FIRE, U.S. Forest Service, and more!












BACKCOUNTRY

BACKCOUNTRY

- Live and work in isolated wilderness April – September
- Build and maintain trails
- Hike long distances daily with 40 to 60 pounds of gear and tools
- Learn techniques like log construction, dry stone masonry, trail design
- Live off the grid for five months, practice Leave No Trace ethics
- Can lead to jobs with National Park Service, U.S. Forest Service, State Parks, and more!
