California Fire Safe Council (CFSC) is pleased to announce 9 projects have been selected for funding for the 2021 Grants Clearinghouse Fire Prevention Program.

CFSC approved \$1.3 million in federal grant funds to support wildfire risk reduction projects in at-risk communities in 8 counties across California.

The selected projects help California communities respond to the growing concern over a catastrophic wildfire and exemplify efforts to create fire-adapted communities. Through subgrants from CFSC, these projects provide support to implement fuel reduction projects such as community chipper programs, fuel breaks, and roadside and defensible space projects. These projects will also utilize educational tools to spread the Fire Safe message and engage community members.

Funding for the 2021 Grants Clearinghouse is provided through master grants to CFSC by the Cooperative Fire Program of the U.S. Forest Service (USFS), Department of Agriculture, Pacific Southwest Region. These State Fire Assistance grants provide \$1,300,000 for subgrants to support:

- Hazardous fuels reduction and maintenance projects on non-federal land
- Community Wildfire Protection Plans and other plans or assessments
- Prevention and mitigation education and outreach opportunities.



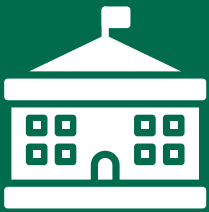

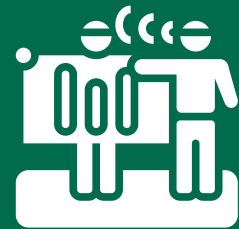
