Indigenous burning practices are integral to sustainable land stewardship. Therefore, a goal of the Santa Barbara TREX is to support Indigenous people, fire practices, and burning objectives to the greatest extent possible, including removing barriers for participation in the week-long intensive training event. When applying to the SB TREX, Indigenous applicants will have the opportunity to request financial support through the Indigenous Stipend Program. Up to \$2853 is available per person to cover costs such as time spent completing pre-event required coursework, travel time, travel costs, and time away from family and work responsibilities.

To apply for the Indigenous Stipend Program, fill out the full SB TREX application. Towards the bottom of that application, there will be additional prompts to apply for the stipend itself.
